CANAL + GROUP RENEWS PREMIER LEAGUE RIGHTS UNTIL 2028 IN FRANCE, SWITZERLAND, CZECH REPUBLIC, SLOVAKIA, AND VIETNAM

The Premier League, more than ever the most competitive national championship in the world, will remain on CANAL+ for 5 further seasons.

Haaland, Salah, De Bruyne, Saka, Son, Rashford, Bernardo Silva, Jesus, Ødegaard, Sterling, Alexander-Arnold, Varane, Nkunku, Konaté... The most popular, most iconic national championship, with its stars, legendary clubs and action-packed derbies.
